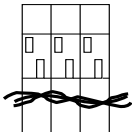

## *SPEEDING*

Lots of you have expressed your concerns regarding the speed of traffic through the village therefore we, as your Association, forwarded these concerns on to Durham County Council and Durham Constabulary. During meetings the County Council stated due to the low traffic flow the cost of “speed humps” or “chicanes” could not be justified. Neither did we fit the criteria for mirrors at certain junctions.



In June Durham Police carried out a speed and traffic flow survey which revealed that although the traffic flow is low, 30% of the traffic exceeds the 30mph speed limit. We have therefore requested Red Rectangles with White SLOW signs be painted on the road either side of the entrance to the bend at Alderson’s Garage, either side of the entrance to The Paddock and anywhere else they may deem necessary.

Although these signs will remind people of the speed limit, only by taking his or her foot off the accelerator will drivers make Waterhouses safer.
