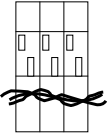

At our last meeting we discussed forthcoming events, including the fair and family fun night on 20 June, a scarecrow competition on 5 September, and a ceilidh on 26 September.

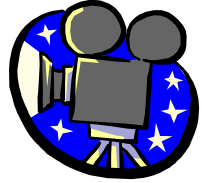
We also heard reports from various members dealing with the development of the hall garden, and the playground area at the rear of Hedley Hill.
